Best Time To Visit :-

Although the climate varies throughout Thailand, you can visit all year round. The best time to travel is during the cool and dry season between November and early April. In the south, the climate differs between the eastern and western coasts. Thailand is however visited all 12 months of the year, even during the summer months of May- August, and by mostly Asian

How To Reach?

Bangkok to Krabi - Direct buses to Krabi operate daily from the Southern Bus Terminal of Bangkok and take up to 10 hours to reach Krabi. Options include air-conditioned and non-air conditioned deluxe and luxury coaches. It's a comfortable drive and aptly suited for backpackers as well as honeymoon couple who wish to enjoy local flavour and culture.

Bangkok to Koh Samui - Although the easiest and fastest way to get to Ko Samui from Bangkok or Phuket or Krabi or Chiang Mai is by a flight, either direct to Ko Samui or to Surat Thani. But one can travel from Bangkok to Surat Thani by Train / Car / Van / Bus and then ferry across to Ko Samui. The train journey overnight is particularly enjoyable for its comfortable laid-back experience.

Phuket to Koh Samui - Travel from Phuket to Don Sak Pier by Car or Van or Bus, and then Ferry to Koh Samui, the total trip duration is about 8 to 9 hours.

Phuket to Krabi - You can get from Phuket to Krabi by ferry, Car, Bus, or taxi. It's a scenic 2 hours drive, and you can enjoy great fresh cut fruits and coffee on the way.

Bangkok to Chiang Mai - Daily trains operate from Bangkok's Hualamphong Train Station to the Chiang Mai Station and take about 12-15 hours to reach Chiang Mai. Easiest and fastest way to fly.

Bangkok to Hua Hin - The best way to experience this beautiful journey is by Train, though it might take more time. The Hua Hin railway station is a beautiful one, too. By road, however, it's the easiest option just 3 hours away if you are able to negotiate Bangkok's traffic smartly.

Bangkok to Khao Yai - A 2 to 3 hours' drive, Khao Yai, the hidden treasure north of Bangkok is a National Park worth visiting for it's serene and beautiful landscape. A UNESCO world heritage site, it's a perfect getaway from Bangkok for families and corporate alike.

Phuket to Pattaya - A 12 hours journey, the Buses are comfortable and stops on the way for food and relaxation, you can opt for it if you have enough time on hands, and if you are running short on money.

Bangkok / Phuket to Ko Pha Ngan - Easiest way is to fly to either Surat Thani or Ko Samui, and then take either Ferry or Speed Boat. The other way is to fly to Phuket and then take Car or Van to Don Sak pier, and then Ferry to either Ko Samui or Ko Pha Ngan. The whole journey takes about 8 hours.

Khao Sok National Park - One may drive from either Phuket or from Surat Thani. From Phuket it takes about 4 hours and from Surat Thani airport, about 2 hours.

festivals of Thailand



Yi Peng (Lantern festival)

Yi Peng festival takes place in the legendary city of Chiang Mai which was once the capital of the Lanna kingdom. Cultural significance for its worn-out fortifications and moats that speak of a foregone era. During Yi Peng in November, Chinese paper lanterns are released into the night sky which is meant to symbolise letting go of the misfortunes of the past year.



Songkran (Water festival)

The water festival is a national holiday that marks the Thai New Year. It takes place on 13th April every year although festivities stretch for at least a week. People clean their houses, pour water over Buddha statues, and drench each other to symbolise cleaning away sins of the past year. Pay tribute to elderly members of the family and their ancestry. It is celebrated all across the country although the biggest festivities can be seen in Chiang Mai, Phuket and Bangkok.



Surin Elephant festival

This festival is a celebration of Thailand's friendly giants. Elephants have been an essential part of Thailand's history, as they have helped in battle, travel, and also in agriculture. In fact, the Hindu deity of Ganesha is hugely popular here, and his statues are a common sight in most towns and villages.



Wing Kwai (Water Buffalo Racing festival)

Takes place in October in the province of Chonburi. It features a race course near Chonburi City Hall that is over 100 metres long. Dozens of jockeys take part in this festival, racing their buffalos bareback to the finish line. Other bovine-related activities include buffalo decoration and a quirky buffalo beauty contest.



Phuket Vegetarian festival

The vegetarian festival of Phuket gains its name from abstinence of meat, garlic, onions and other food groups for one month before the festival. It culminates in a massive celebration in October. One of the most gruesome festivals in Thailand as revellers take part in body mortification like face-piercings, walking on hot coals and laying on a bed of knives. There are also fireworks, energetic dancing and chanting involved. Participants believe that this will convince the gods to protect you from harm.



Lopburi Monkey Banquet (Food Festival)

Legend has it that the Hindu deity Hanuman saved a god's daughter from a demon in Thailand and monkeys have been gladly welcomed here ever since. Most commonly found in ancient towns such as Lopburi which is located 150 kilometres north of Bangkok. Local people conduct a huge monkey banquet every November as a celebration of these apes. The banquet has fruits, vegetables and seeds kept on offer for the 3,000 monkeys that live in Lopburi's temple area.



Chinese New Year

Takes place in January or February, depending on the lunar calendar, it has become a major festival in Thailand because of a large Chinese population here. It is best celebrated in Yaowarat which is the Chinatown of Bangkok. One can witness firecrackers across the sky, and traditional dragon dancers on the streets.



Mother's Day & Father's Day

Mark the birthdays of their rulers as Mother's Day and Father's Day in the country, Mother's Day is celebrated on the Queen's birthday on August 12th while Father's Day is celebrated on December 5th. Both days are national holidays marked by festivities such as parades, music performances, traditional food stalls and visits to the temple. On Mother's Day, mothers are invited to their children's schools where there are songs and dances performed in their honour. On Father's Day, it is customary to wear yellow or golden attire. Both days see huge decorations across the cities of Thailand

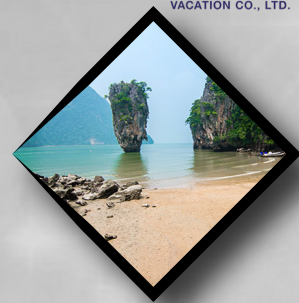


Candle festival

Takes place in Ubon Ratchathani in southeast Thailand. It is held in July on the days of Asanha Puja (which commemorates Buddha's first sermon) and Wan Khao Pansa (which marks the beginning of Buddhist Lent). Large wax sculptures are created to be paraded on massive floats. These wax sculptures are created through the influence of traditional and modern art aesthetics while the candles represent different districts of Thailand. Some candles are carved with scenes of Hindu and Buddhist mythology.

• THAILAND - LUXURY AMIDST NATURE



For travelers with interest in Architectural / Historical / Heritage / Religious sites, a trip to Nakhon Pathom is a must. An area of great historical importance, it blends the features of archeological and religious treasures. One of the foremost being the Phra Pathom Chedi, which is considered the first religious landmark that signified the introduction of Buddhism to Thailand. Photography enthusiasts are bound to find the plains along the Tha Cheen River quite fascinating. The fertile lands of Amphoe Nakhom Chaisi, Amphoe Sam Phran, and Amphoe Bang Len make for some great shots as it provides agricultural opportunities for the locals, and thus, there are vast plantations, crop farms and fruit orchards here. As you make your road trip, stop by to take some shots with lotus flower collectors in the early morning hours. Try the delicious “Pomelo” fruit, too. There are many who call Nakhom Pathom the sweet pomelo town with good reason. Bird watching in mangrove swamps: Ko Phra Thong enjoys the title of “Safari in the midst of the Andamans”. There is also a beach that stretches along the west coast, the mangrove swamps on the northern and eastern part of the island.

Ayutthaya Tour



Ayutthaya, the old Thai capital, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is one of the most impressive ruined cities in Asia and a must-see for history buffs visiting Thailand.

Founded in 1350, The Menam, Lopburi, and Pasak rivers ring Ayutthaya Historical Park, the island where most of the temple ruins lie.

Popular things to do include caring for rescued elephants and biking through the old French, Portuguese, British, and Dutch quarters.

Wat Yai Chai Mongkhon and Wat Phra Sri Sanphet are two most popular and worth-visiting temples. Floating Market - Ayutthaya Floating Market covers a vast area of approximately 70 acres and is regarded as the largest tourist attraction in Phra Nakhon Si Ayutthaya Province, in the aspect of cultural heritage conservation.

Khao Lak Tour



Khao Lak is a series of villages. Khao Lak means Lak Mountain. Beaches in this place are less crowded, so you can enjoy a lot here. It has not only beaches but also 20 kms stretch of coast. There are mainly 3 tourist oriented places in Khao Lak are: Bang La On, Bang Niang & Khuk Khak.

Thailand's most famous Full Moon Party takes place on the infamous party island of Koh Phangan. It's 12 kms north from the traveler hotspot of Koh Samui and 45 kms from the prevalent diving paradise of Koh Tao.

Haad Rin Beach in Koh Phangan is the location that buzz and explodes with myriad party theme. Wine, Food, and Music take centerstage though the party has numerous shades and theme. The party begins at dusk, When the round yellow moon makes its appearance over the white sand beach. In twilight, small tables are lined up on the beach and thousands of lamps are lit..

As the evening progresses the beach explodes into a dancing frenzy as different emcees and performers take their turn on the decks. There is something for everyone here, trance, techno, drum and bass, commercial dance and reggae, no-one is disappointed. Jugglers and fire-eaters entertain the crowds as the night goes on and with the brilliant impromptu fireworks display, the party atmosphere is complete.
